2010 AIHEC Archery Competition Official Tournament Rules

- Once a shooter begins shooting a course he/she must finish with his/her own group or as assigned by range official. Any shooter or group that leaves a range without the authorization of a range official will not be allowed to continue.
- To score, arrows must be stuck in the target. Teams will match up with an archer from another team and keep each others score. Targets must be scored by both scorekeepers before arrows are pulled. Early pulled arrows score – 0.
- Any arrow released accidentally or deliberately will be, if not in scoring area of target, scored as an 0. Any arrow, which is dropped and can be recovered while touching the stake may be re-nocked and re-shot.
- **11** – Small circle centered within the ten ring. Approximately 25% of the ten ring will be used. Arrow must at least touch the circle. This score would reflect 11 on the scorecard. **10** – Circle inside vital area. Arrow must at least touch circle. **8** – Vital area other than the 10 point circle. Arrow must at least touch the vital area line. **5** – Remainder of the animal touching body color. **0** - A hit in the horn or hoof not touching body color, any other miss, or glance off. IBO scoring rules
- Each following shooter in the group will have two minutes to shoot his or her arrow. This two minute time limit begins when the shooter before you in your group releases his or her arrow. Archery teams will shoot two rounds at twenty targets; archers will shoot two arrows per target.
- Bows may include; take down recurve, recurve, wood or metal recurve with no sighting device and stabilizers or counter balances shall not be allowed. There will be no markings on the bow or on the bowstring that could be construed as sighting marks. There may be only one nocking point on the string. The arrows shall be of the same materials and in uniform length and weight, with screw in style or glued on points. A minimum of three (3) 4" vanes or feathers, dyna vanes or similar are allowed. All arrows must be shot with no finger tabs or glove.
- Teams will consist of four members, male or female does not matter put your best shooters on your team. Limited to one team per college. Single competition archers will also shoot the same but they will have an on sight judge keeping their score or they can have an archer from another school keep their score.
- Tournament committee will not be responsible for thefts or injuries. Team in violation of the above said rules can be disqualified from competition. Shooting equipment will be provided for team members.
- Sportsmanship is required so please be respectful and enjoy the art of competition.
